- **Welcome to Troop 149 Document** – Parents please read before signing your son up.
- **Troop 149 Code of Conduct form**
 - Must be on file with the Troop prior to attending the first outing.
 - To be signed by the Scout and their parent(s)/guardian(s)
- **Boy Scout Youth Application**
 - Must be completed and returned to the Troop prior to Scout attending the first outing.
 - Troop 149 pays the registration fees
 - To be completed by the parent(s)/guardian(s)
- **BSA Annual Health and Medical Form & Copy of Insurance Card (front and back)**
 - Parts A & B must be on file with the Troop prior to attending the first outing.
 - Parts A, B, and C must be on file prior to Summer Camp or planned extended outing over 3 days.
 - To be completed by the parent(s)/guardian(s)
- **Contact/E-list information**
 - This is vitally important. Email is the primary form of communication used by Troop leadership via its TroopTrack website. Upon completion and submission of this form, the Troop Webmaster will set up an account for your family to receive emails from the TroopTrack website and for you to access the information on TroopTrack.
